## The Jepson Center Telfair Museum of Art Savannah, Georgia

Founded in 1886, the Telfair Museum of Art is the oldest art museum in the South. The new Jepson Center is its first addition since construction in 1875. The new building adds 64,000 s.f. and includes 66% more exhibition and educational spaces, outdoor sculpture terraces, a 220-seat auditorium, a café and a store. Since a key focus of the Center is early education, it includes a unique hands-on gallery especially for children and their families: the ArtZeum.
